I KEPT DRAWING UNTIL I FOUND THE CHARACTERS' VOICES.


THE METHOD WAS SIMPLE, GET AN IDEA FOR A SITUATION, THROW THE CHARACTERS IN AND SEE HOW THEY PULL THROUGH IT.

SOME STRIPS DID GREAT IN DRIVING THEIR IDEA ACROSS, AND SOME ONLY STARTED AS A GOOD IDEA BUT LANDED FLAT DURING EXECUTION, SO THEY WERE SCRAPPED.



I USED TO DO A LOT OF OUT-OF-CONTINUITY PAGES LIKE THESE BACK THEN, SINCE THAT IS USUALLY HOW MOST STORIES START AND DEVELOP, MEANING ELLIOT HAD ALREADY ARRIVED IN THE DOCTOR'S HOUSE LONG BEFORE.

SO TO AVOID CONFUSING NEW READERS, I WILL SAVE THE OLD VS. NEW STORYLINE FOR THE NEXT VOLUME'S BONUS CONTENT.


